

Minutes of Special Town Board Meeting

To inspect Town Roads

May 6, 2014

The Town Board met on May 6, 2014 for the purpose of inspecting the condition of the roads in the town. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe DeBaker at the Town Hall at 8:30 AM. Present were DeBaker, Schultz, and Spiegel. It was noted that the meeting had been properly posted at the Leopolis Post Office, Pederson's Bar, Gresham Post Office and Gresham Bank.

After discussing the primary goals of the inspection the Board departed the Town Hall at 8:32 to conduct the inspection.

After completing the road inspection, the Board returned to the Town Hall at 1:20 PM.

A discussion of Chip sealing projects, based on the board's observations resulted in the consensus that we should remove Old County A from or project list entirely due to the low volume of traffic on this road. It was also the Board's consensus that we should delay chip sealing Gruenewald and Herman Streets for one year.

A discussion of Crack Filling, based on the board's observations ensued. It was decided that we would look at two options for crack filling. The first option would be to crack fill Leopolis Road north of 29, Roosevelt Road between G and Schmidt Road, and Schmidt Road. These are some of our newest roads and are beginning to show some cracking. The second option would be to significantly increase the amount of money we spend on crack filling this year and crack fill Lyndhurst Road, Herman Street, and Gruenewald Street from Herman to Hillview. DeBaker was authorized to contact Crack Filling Services to get estimates of the cost of these two options along with their recommendation.

It was noted that although \$3,000 is budgeted for patchwork on dead end roads, we did not observe any needs in this area. Thus we should save most, if not all of that money in the budget.

Duane accepted the responsibility of coordinating our brush control project this year.
