Special Town Board Meeting about Leopold Pond

A special Town Board meeting was held at the Town Hall on September 2, 2016 for the purpose of deciding what to do about the milfoil in the Leopold pond.

Chairman DeBaker called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

Present were Chairman DeBaker, Supervisor #1 Spiegel, and Supervisor #2 Schultz. Bob Kristof was also in attendance. It was noted that the meeting had been properly posted at Pederson's Bar, the Leopold Post Office and on the Town web site.

DeBaker brought the board up to date on his discussions with the DNR concerning a drawdown of the pond over winter for the purpose of killing the milfoil. One key element was that the DNR has determined that a permit will not be required so it can be done this year if it can be completed by October 1. The only requirement is that a drawdown plan must be approved by the DNR. DeBaker shared with the board a drawdown plan that he had submitted to the DNR. No reply has been received as yet.

Schultz made a motion, seconded by Spiegel, that the town proceeds with a drawdown of the Leopold Pond as per the plan written by DeBaker pending DNR approval. Vote was 3 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.
