

Resolution No. 2013 - 1

A resolution concerning a Town policy on granting exceptions to posted weight limits on town roads

Whereas, the Town of Herman has a responsibility to maintain town roads, and


Whereas, Section 349.16(1)(a) gives the Town authority to set special weight limits on town roads which, because of weakness of the roadbed, would likely be seriously damaged in the absence of such limits, and

Whereas, it is desirable to have a consistent policy when exceptions from posted weight limits are requested, therefore


Be It Resolved that it is the policy of the Town of Herman that no exceptions shall be granted to exceed the posted weight limits except for a vehicle that is used to transport material pumped from a septic or holding tank as required by state law, and for the Town of Herman's garbage collection contractor and snow plowing contractor, and

Be it further resolved that consideration be given to removing all road weight limits during the months that the ground is frozen.


