

RESOLUTION # 2013-2

A resolution granting in-street parking privileges to Darold Raasch

WHEREAS, Darold Raasch is currently the Town of Herman Contractor for snow plowing, and

WHEREAS, Darold Raasch has expressed to the Town of Herman Town Board a need to use that portion of Schmidt Street which lies to the west of his shop for storage of snow plowing equipment during the plowing season, and

WHEREAS, Darold Raasch has pointed out to the Town Board that, unless he is able to park equipment on that portion of the street, he will need to raze the currently used salt shed and use that area for parking, and

WHEREAS, with no salt storage area on his property, Darold Raasch will need to make multiple trips to Shawano to pick up salt sand which will result in significant costs to the Town of Herman, and


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Town of Herman Town Board that no land would be blocked from access if Darold Raasch were granted in street parking privileges, and


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Town of Herman Town Board that granting such permission is in the public interest of the Town of Herman,


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the town board of the Town of Herman hereby grants Darold Raasch permission to park equipment as needed on the north half of the platted street identified as Schmidt Street on the village plat of Lyndhurst which extends to the west of his existing building, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, this permission shall be in force from September 1 through April 30 each year as long as Darold Raasch is the snow plow contractor for the Town of Herman and as long as land ownership continues such as to not cause a lack of access to any parcel of land.
