

PLAN COMMISSION RESOLUTION
AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
FOR THE TOWN OF HERMAN IN SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, section 66.1001(4), Wisconsin Statutes, establishes the required procedure for a local government to amend a comprehensive plan, and section 66.1001(2) identifies the required elements of a comprehensive plan; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Herman Plan Commission has the authority to recommend that the Town Board amend a "comprehensive plan" under section 66.1001(4)(b); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Plan Commission of the Town of Herman hereby recommends an amendment to the *Comprehensive Plan* of the Town of Herman to bring the 2008 plan in accordance with current county, state, federal and regional plans and ordinances as well as update demographic and community data, timetables, figures and maps.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Plan Commission certifies a copy of the attached *Resolution* to the Town Board; and


